Here are our must-visit attractions when visiting the Tuscan capital of Florence:

Galleria degli Uffizi

Visit Galleria degli Uffizi, home to some of the world's greatest Italian renaissance art including works by Leonardo da Vinci, Botticelli and Michelangelo. As well as holding treasures on the inside, the gallery building itself boasts breathtakingly beautiful 15th century Italian architecture.



La Terrazza rooftop bar

Florence cathedral

Originally called Il Duomo di Firenze, this enchanting dome roofed gothic cathedral is the main church of Florence and vaunts panoramic views across the city. Arguably the most important landmark in Florence, its simply got to be ticked off.
